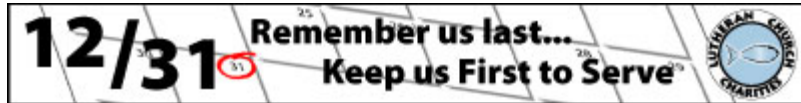

## Lutheran Family of Five Loses Everything in Fire

Request from Pastor Mike Gudgel, St. Matthew Lutheran Church, Lemont



Screams of terror were heard shortly after the first worship service on Sunday morning at St. Matthew in Lemont. A young mom had just received a phone call from her husband and heard the horrific news: their house was on fire. Every member of the family was fine, but their house and most of their belongings were



destroyed. The mom is an active member of our congregation and serves part-time as our custodian. Her three daughters, ages 6, 5, and 2 were overcome with grief, especially at the thought of losing their Christmas presents. Their father is a union electrician and has been out of work for over a year. The congregation has stepped in to help with their immediate needs but the losses are tremendous. Any type of financial assistance for this family would be

greatly appreciated.

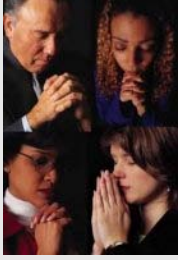

## God's on the Go in Ghana

### Help Provide the Biblical Study Books needed in Mission Field

Ghanaian Seminary Students at Ft. Wayne Seminary Need Books for the Lutheran Church in Ghana

Gary and Bill (names being withheld for protection), training to be Lutheran Pastors at the Ft. Wayne Seminary, met with LCC staff members to describe their ministries in Ghana and ways we can assist them. Their primary request was for books so that they can set up a second training library in Ghana. The Lutheran Church in Ghana has a seminary with a library, and they are looking to create a second library location so pastors and

Christian leaders in the country do not have to travel to Accra, the capitol of Ghana, to do their study and research. They are in desperate need of well-trained pastors and leaders - there are over 25,000 members of the Lutheran Church in Ghana and only 50 pastors, with an additional 40 "evangelists" or lay ministers. They fear religious "pluralism" in their country and want well trained leaders to combat a pick-and-choose approach of people's beliefs and practices between Lutheranism, other Christian churches like Presbyterian and Pentecostal, Islam and even some tribal beliefs.

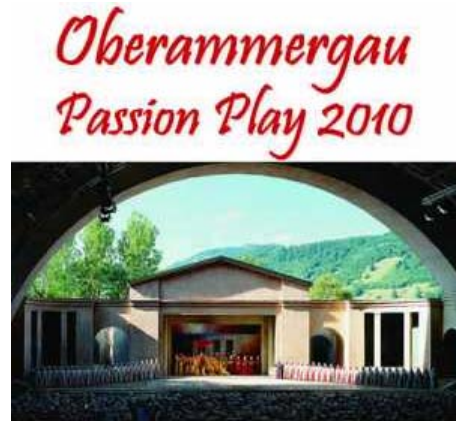
Join Tim Hetzner this summer for a trip to Germany, Austria and other central European sites, including the world-famous Oberammergau Passion Play!

- A space large enough where we can drive in and store our Disaster response RV and trailers for immediate DEPLOYMENT.
- A cargo bay allowing us the ability to load semi-trailers would also be nice and useful feature.

We understand that use of the warehouse would not be permanent and that the owner would have the full rights to regain their facility if it was to be rented or sold. 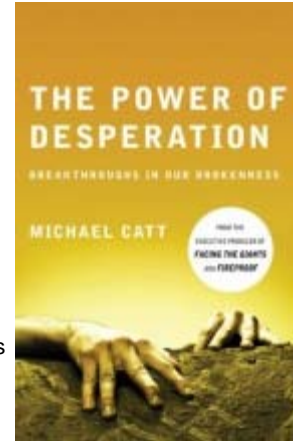

## Tim's Pick of the Week

### [Power of Desperation](#)

What could be good about being broken?
