Many of you have heard about the incredible work done by Chaplain Ralph Buckhorn and his team of therapy dogs at NIU in the aftermath of the February shooting. In thinking about the most effective strategy for utilizing his team again, we have concluded that a visit before the end of the school year would have the greatest impact on the students (by the Fall there will be 8,000 new students and about as many will have left; simply put, it will be a different place completely next Fall). There is a small window of time where the foundation built in their first trip can be built upon most effectively and that is before school lets out for the summer. Chaplain Ralph and his team are available the



week before finals -
the week of May 3rd .

This is a time when students will be stressed yet still going about "normal" academic life. In speaking with Extra Miles, it is estimated that \$4500 can cover travel and housing for four dogs and the National team members coming from their home base in California. Our campus ministry, Extra Mile ministries and Lutheran Church Charities are hoping you will partner with us in raising the funds necessary to see this unique ministry opportunity realized. On behalf of all of NIU, thank you for your prayers, your concern and your kind words as

we ask for your prayerful consideration of this request.

Well here is what we did! First we ordered wood, nails, rope, and other supplies and decided to build a play set along with a soccer field. Next we got 40 soldiers and 10 Iraqi's to volunteer their time to build this. Finally, we ordered 10 soccer balls and 5 kick balls.

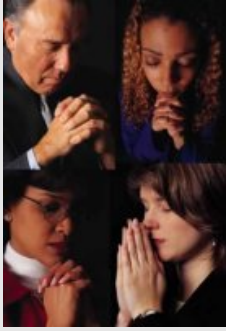

Audalee McLoughlin, President and CEO indicated that within 48 hours of the fire they had apartments for the girls and their babies. She took the time to explain that at the time of the fire all 20 moms and 30 children were out of the building where the fire took place. They were grateful that everyone was contained in one spot. In addition, with the help of their alderman and state representative, the officials had the building inspected and issued the building permits within two days of the fire and the reconstruction could begin.

Another large need is the need of nice jeans, pants and shoes for the moms. This is a necessity when they are looking for jobs and applying to schools.

survivor of domestic violence, Melissa
moved her family to Illinois in hopes of
building a better life. Melissa and her
children were residing with family but due
to an unexpected death in the family,
Melissa and her children are facing
homelessness.



Melissa needs a van to transport her family to and from
emergency shelter sites. Also, all six children are enrolled in
school and Melissa is their transportation. Melissa is actively
seeking employment and a reliable vehicle is a necessity. The
vehicle Melissa currently uses is unsafe, unreliable, and too small.

On the upside, Melissa and her family were recently approved for
the Housing Choice Voucher Program. This program provides
low income families with affordable housing. Melissa is in the
process of locating housing in the school district in which her
children attend.

[Pagan Christianity: Exposing the Roots of Our Church Practices](#)

By Frank Viola & George Barna / Barna Books

Many Christians take for granted that their Sunday morning worship service is rooted in the New Testament, but why does the church in the New Testament seem very different from our own expressions of corporate worship? Frank Viola and George Barna come to the startling conclusion that most of what Christians do in church is rooted more in pagan culture than in the New Testament.

Discover how many church customs really originated. This thought-provoking exploration into the background of how believers have worshiped for centuries uncovers many non-Christian roots. From the order of worship to the pastor's sermon, traditional dress codes to Christian education, Viola and Barna take a revealing look at Sunday morning. 304 pages, hardcover from Barna Books.

Frank Viola is an influential voice in the contemporary house church movement. Frank is a nationally recognized expert on new trends in the church, holds conferences on the deeper

He is also the founder and directing leader of the Barna Group, a research and resource firm in Ventura California.
