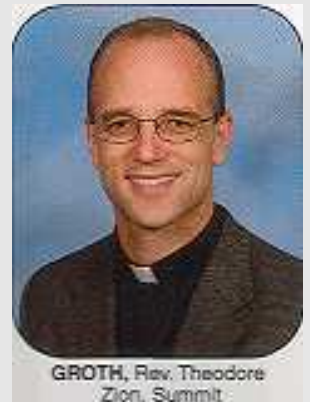
Elderly Man Needs Car to Receive Medical Treatment

I am working with a family who is in need of a car. The grandmother lives in Niles and provides housing for herself, her 19 year old daughter and her daughter's young baby.

Both of the women work in Buffalo Grove at low paying jobs and have to rely on public transportation to get to work. If they miss the second bus connection and have to take a taxi for the last leg home the day's commute charge is \$13.50. Grocery shopping is a ¾ mile walk each way and in bad weather also means the cost of a taxi. This woman is desperately trying to provide for herself, daughter and granddaughter but without a reliable car they are at the mercy of public transportation.

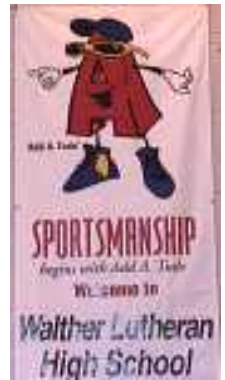

Greetings!

Recently, our family received word of an invitation from Kids Alive to serve in Kenya as partners in their ministry. This trip will take place in November 2007 and last for four weeks. We have eagerly accepted this challenge and wanted to share in this experience with you. If you are unfamiliar with Kids Alive it is a Christian organization that rescues orphans from the streets of third world countries. This opportunity to serve in Kenya comes after a six-month examination process by Kids Alive to determine if we are qualified to serve as long-term missionaries. 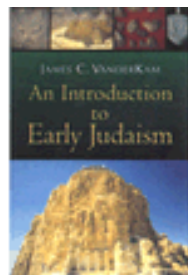
