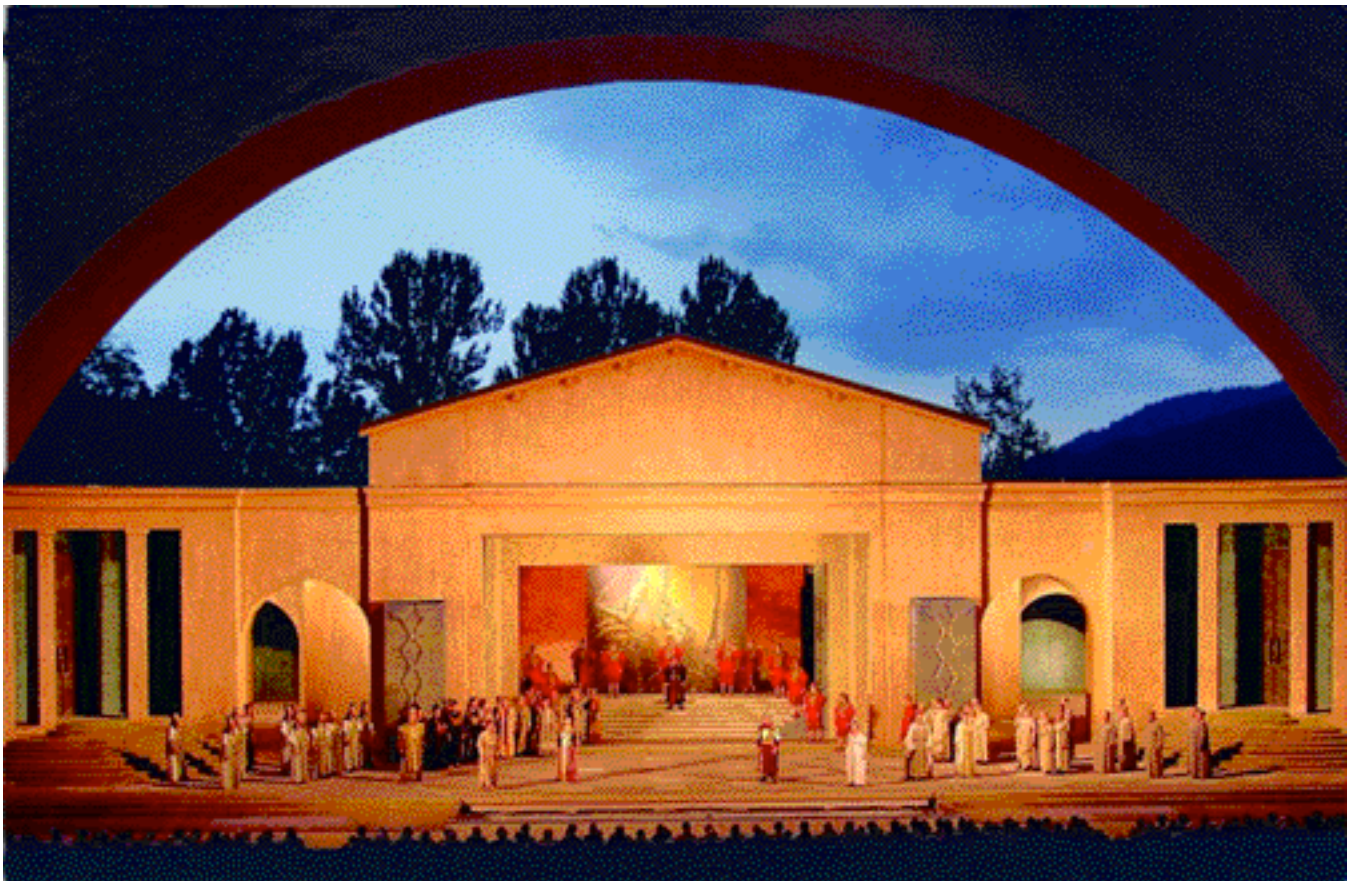

THE **Promise**

It was during the Thirty Years War that the deadly and contagious disease known as the Black Plague broke out. Before it ran its course, it struck down one in every three persons throughout Europe, and left in its wake untold misery, panic and hunger.

But one little village in the south of Germany was spared; Oberammergau. The townspeople of Oberammergau made a vow that if they were spared, they would give a play of the life of Christ every ten years. The fact they were saved is one of the most amazing mysteries in history. Thus, the first *Passion Play* took place in 1634. Originally it was a small performance, played on a meadow, by the villagers and local peasants. Throughout the years, however, Oberammergau has produced several gifted poets who have set the Play to verse as well as lengthened it, until it achieved its present form as an artistic masterwork. To qualify as actors, the performers must be native Oberammergauers, amateurs, and persons of high moral and ethical principles. It is a great honor to be chosen to play the part of a saint and the highest earthly honor to be chosen to play the part of Christ.

For the Oberammergauers, the Play is a labor of love. Their vow is still the most important thing in their lives, and with great pride they are now preparing the presentation for the Oberammergau *Passion Play* of 2010.

We recognize that cost may be an issue for some people. But, we also understand the needs and requirements of all of our past travelers. Please note that the tour costs are based on land and air rates that are in effect as of August, 2007. Also, passports must be valid through the beginning of 2011. Should you need to renew your passport or apply for a new one, it would be wise to begin the process 12 to 18 months prior to your trip's departure date.

Thursday, August 12, 2010 - Chicago Departure: We depart today on our flights to Germany. Meals are served on our trans-Atlantic flight.

Friday, August 13 - Munich / Salzburg: Upon arrival at the Munich Airport, we'll be greeted by our professional tour manager. We will motor into Munich for our orientation tour that will pass the Olympic Stadium and visit the Marienplatz with its famous glockenspiel. After some free time to enjoy Munich, we'll continue our journey to Austria. Our first view of Salzburg will be of the copper domes and belfries in the old city and of the silhouette of the mighty fortress-castle against the backdrop of mountains. There will be free time to stroll in the old city after dinner this evening. Overnight in Salzburg. (SD)

Salzburg's storybook skyline of bell towers and spires, the baroque palaces, the medieval castle, and the eclectic street life of sidewalk musicians inspires imagination. Salzburg is a splendid city for walking and seeing the sights. It is also well-known for its small tunnels and alleys which are filled with shops and restaurants.

Saturday, August 14 - Salzburg: The highlights of our morning walking tour will include the Cathedral where Mozart was baptized and the 12th century St. Peter's Church. The remainder of the afternoon and evening are at leisure. Overnight in Salzburg. (B)

Sunday, August 15 - Salzburg / *Sound of Music* Tour / Innsbruck: Our morning tour follows the trail of the *Sound of Music*. Driving into the Salzkammergut, Austria's lake district, we visit the beautiful lakeside resort of St. Wolfgang, famous for its White Horse Inn. In Mondsee, we'll visit the village church where the wedding scene of the *Sound of Music* was filmed. Later, we continue through the Tyrol which brings to mind Alpine valleys, rushing rivers, and villages of flower-covered chalets. Upon arrival in Innsbruck, our afternoon walking tour of the old city will include the historic and architecturally beautiful Maria-Theresienstrasse to see the Goldenes Dachl (the Golden Roof of Maximilian's Balcony). Overnight in Innsbruck - our home for two nights. (B, D)

Monday, August 16 - Bolzano Excursion / Dolomites / St. Ulrich / Innsbruck: This morning takes us over the famous Brenner Pass into northern Italy where we visit Bolzano. The city's Italian-Austrian character, enhanced by the narrow cobblestone streets, gives it the unique flavor of a city at the crossroads between Italian and Austrian cultures. Later, we pass through the Dolomites and see its sheer pink and yellow limestone pinnacles

that tower over quaint villages, flowery meadows, wooded valleys, and sun-soaked trails. Italian, Austrian, and ancient Ladin cultures intermingle peacefully in the small, scattered villages in this mountainous corner of Italy. We will have some free time to explore the quiet village of St. Ulrich, also known by its Ladin name of Ortisei. The residents of this charming village, in the heart of the very traditional Val Gardena, display their talents in the town's boutiques and artist studios. We'll return to Innsbruck in the late afternoon for dinner and our overnight. (B, D)

Tuesday, August 17 - Innsbruck / the Island of Mainau / Lucerne: This morning we'll cross the Arlberg Pass en route to beautiful Konstanz. Here, we'll visit the island of Mainau, known as the "flower island." It is a unique experience for the senses, with its thousands of colors, shapes and scents. In the spring, tulips, narcissus and orchids bloom; in May, rhododendrons; in summer, roses; and in the autumn, dahlias, as far as the eye can see. Palms, citrus fruits and butterflies spread a tropical flair. Later, we continue to Lucerne, the jewel of Swiss resorts, our home for two nights. (B, D)

Wednesday, August 18 - Lucerne: The highlights of our morning walking tour will include the Lion Monument, commemorating the death of the brave Swiss guards; the old, covered wooden bridge across the Reuss River; and the charming architecture of the old city. The afternoon is free to shop for Swiss watches, cuckoo clocks or to take an optional tour to Mt. Pilatus. Overnight in Lucerne. (B)

Thursday, August 19 - Lucerne / Hohenschwangau: Today, we motor through the spectacular Swiss and Bavarian countryside en route to Hohenschwangau. This afternoon we'll visit King Ludwig II's most famous castle, Neuschwanstein. While being a formidable fortress, it was designed by a theatrical decorator, not an architect, which explains its dream-like atmosphere. Our lovely hotel is located in Hohenschwangau, overlooking Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau Castles. (B, D)

Friday, August 20 - Oberammergau: The morning will be free for shopping or just strolling along the streets of this charming village. This afternoon and evening, we'll attend the *Passion Play*. Our overnight is in Oberammergau. (B, L, D)

Oberammergau is known for its painted houses ... this colorful style of *trompe-l'oeil* or *Luftmalerei* can be seen throughout the village. The town has an international reputation not only for the *Passion Play*, but also for its woodcarvings.

Saturday, August 21 - Oberammergau / Munich Airport / Chicago: This morning, we bid farewell to our tour manager and driver and begin our return journey home from the Munich airport. Arrive Chicago in the afternoon.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

CANCELLATIONS per person: All cancellations must be in writing and delivered to Passion Play 2010, Inc. c/o Trans World Travel, Inc. (TWT). A \$200.00 administrative fee will be charged for any cancellation. Also, cancellations after 04/01/08 will also be subject to additional penalties that may be assessed by airlines, hotels, cruise lines, tour operators, attractions, motor coach companies, and the PASSION PLAY COMMITTEE.

PLUS the following:

- 1) Cancellation penalty after 01/01/09, 10% of tour cost per person.
- 2) Cancellation penalty after 09/01/09, 20% of tour cost per person.*
- 3) Cancellations postmarked within 90 days of departure, penalty 100% of tour cost per person.

***Additionally**, unless a replacement tour member is found, a cancelling tour member will also be charged for the single supplement fee of one's non-cancelling roommate plus cost of Passion Play package.

CANCELLATION OF TOUR

TWT reserves the right to cancel any tour prior to departure for any reason, including insufficient number of participants, in which case a full refund will be given. Operator also has the right to withdraw your membership at any time if your actions impose upon or disturb the other members of the tour. All additional costs to send a tour member home will be borne by the tour member.

PARTIAL OR COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL AFTER TOUR BEGINS

Once the tour has commenced, no refund will be made for any used and unused portion of the tour.

INSURANCE

An optional insurance plan is available. We strongly encourage all tour members to purchase and maintain trip cancellation, health and baggage insurance.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Individual seating requests cannot be guaranteed due to Airline seating policies.

HOTEL CLASSIFICATIONS

We use Government-rated 3 and 4-star hotels that are chosen on the basis of location, cleanliness and services and when possible, are typical of the local area or the best accommodations available in a particular city.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

Excluded is any accommodation not expressly written as being included in the tour package – such as cost of passports, visas where required, portage at airports and/or ship docks, gratuities on all cruise ships, tips to tour manager, motor coach driver, or guide, optional tours, and any other items of a personal nature including beverages with included meals. No responsibility is incurred by tour operator for loss of or damage to baggage or any of the passenger's belongings.

DEVIATIONS

Deviations from the group itinerary will be quoted separately and require completion of a "Request for Deviation" form. Changes are subject to a \$100. per person fee plus any other travel related fees from airlines, hotels, etc.

ITINERARY CHANGES

Occasionally, a change in a portion of your tour, accommodations, services, etc. may be necessitated due to: altered transportation schedules/equipment, weather conditions, labor strikes, road construction, or for other unforeseen reasons outside the control of tour operator. Any resultant expenses shall be borne by the passengers.

RATES

All rates in this brochure are based on applicable tariffs in effect at the time of printing - Sept. 2007. Tour price may be subject to change without notice due to the occurrence of currency fluctuations, the increase in fuel, increase in air tickets, various taxes, or any other increase connected with the tour package. Any cancellation due to any of the above changes is subject to TWT's cancellation policy.

For international travel all U.S. citizens must have a current passport with 9 months validity remaining from your return date.
